If my child is placed in a class *other than Clase de Padres e Hijos*, I understand that I will be required to pay **\$100 non-refundable** registration fee no later than *10 days after I receive notification of my child's placement*. If my child is placed in *Clase de Padres e Hijos*, I understand I will be required to pay a **\$25 non-refundable fee** no later than *10 days after I receive notification of my child's placement*. I understand that failure to pay these fees will jeopardize my child's placement. In addition, I agree to abide by the policies set forth in the *Tuition & Fees Statement*, which I received with my application.

PARENTAL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Warren W. Cherry Preschool is an independent, parent-governed, not-for-profit, non-sectarian preschool open to all children in our community. The school admits students of any race, color and national or ethnic origin, and does not discriminate in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, financial aid program, or other school administered programs. Cherry Preschool exists without the sponsorship of a larger institution, thus enjoying independence, stability, and the benefits of being able to focus all its energies on innovative, developmentally appropriate early childhood educational programs.
